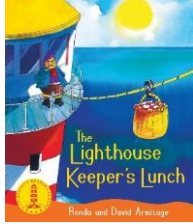

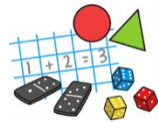

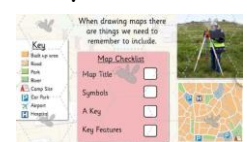

Artist Study and Observational drawing of shells
