

Regular Readers

Each child is given a reading diary to record books shared at home. It is also a dialogue with your class teacher who will look at it each week. Please share stories with your child at home as encouraging an early love of stories will give your child the very best start!

Helpful hints to support reading:

- *Look at the front cover and talk about it and read the title.*
- *Look through the book and talk about the pictures.*
- *Get them to join in with some parts if they can.*
- *Let them hold the book and turn the pages.*
- *Re-read the same books and after reading talk about the story and ask them questions such as 'Did you enjoy it?', 'Which part did you like?' and 'Why?'*

Every Friday your child will receive a stamp in their book if they have read at least 5 times in a week. Please initial their reading diary each time you have shared a story together.

If they have read 5 times a week at home over a 4 week period, then they will receive a certificate and a prize!

We change books with the children on a Monday and Friday.
