Communication & Language Development

We will be...

- Listening to traditional tales, learning new vocabulary and talking about our experiences.
- Starting to learn how to blend CVC words using oral blending and objects.
- Starting to learn how to hear the same initial sound for words and names of objects.



At home, you could talk about familiar books and encourage me to retell stories we read often at home.

Understanding the World

We will be...

- Understanding the need to respect and care for the natural environment and all living things.
- Revisiting learning about fire safety.
- Celebrating and valuing cultural, religious and community events and experiences.
- Talking about the differences between materials and changes we notice when cooking.



At home, you could share family photographs and discuss the importance of celebrations such as Christmas, Remembrance Day or Bonfire Night.

Literacy

We will be...

- Reading, retelling and sequencing traditional tales.
- Engaging in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary.
- Understanding concepts about print.
- Practicing name writing and name recognition.
- Ascribing meaning to the marks we make.



At home, you could share what you're writing as you write a shopping list or point out familiar logos or door numbers.

Mathematics

We will be...

- Singing and acting out number rhymes.
- Talking about, identifying and making patterns.
- Carefully counting objects and understanding the cardinal value of numbers 0, 1, 2 and 3.
- Making comparisons between objects relating to size.
- Comparing quantities using language: 'more than', 'fewer than' or 'the same'.



At home, you could count with me as you put my clothes on, like "one sock, two socks" or "one button, two buttons, three buttons".

Expressive Arts & Design

We will be...

- Exploring mixed media through creation of Christmas decorations and cards.
- Creating art work inspired by Yayoi Kusama.
- Acting out stories using everyday objects like different sized bowls, chairs and construction materials.
- Developing complex stories using small world equipment like animal sets and dolls houses.



At home, you could explore the different sounds made with everyday things like spoons, pots and plastic bowls.

Physical Development

We will be...

- Developing our fine motor skills by work with tweezers, playdough, chalks, scissors etc.
- Taking part in Sure Tots and Music and Movement sessions.
- Remembering sequences and patterns of movements which are related to music and rhythm.



At home, you could encourage your child to have a go at different fastenings like buttons, Velcro and zips.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will be...

- Exploring feelings through story characters.
- Making healthy choices about food and drink and learning about tooth brushing.
- Talking about friendship and how to be a good friend.
- Becoming increasingly able to follow rules, understanding why they are important.



At home, you could encourage me to meet my own care needs, e.g. brushing teeth, using the toilet, washing and drying hands thoroughly.

We will be sharing some winter themed stories over the week linked to activities.

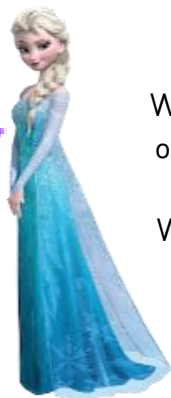
We will start the week with Christmas themed PE session.
