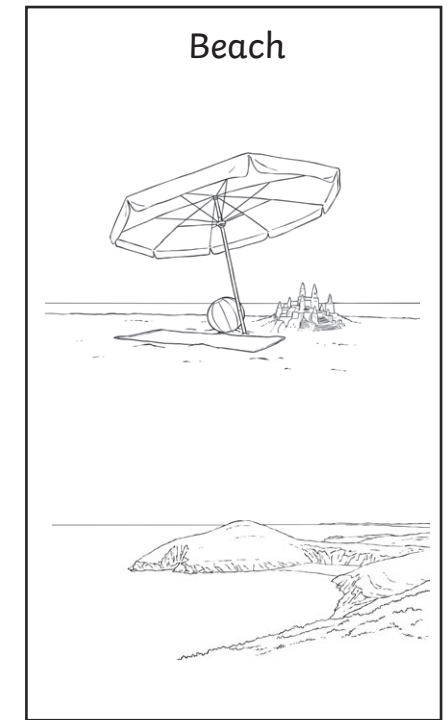
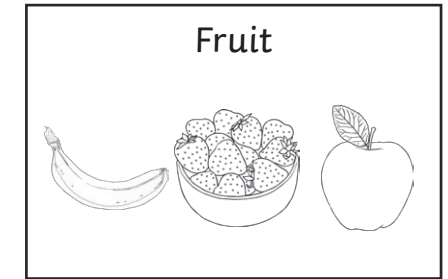
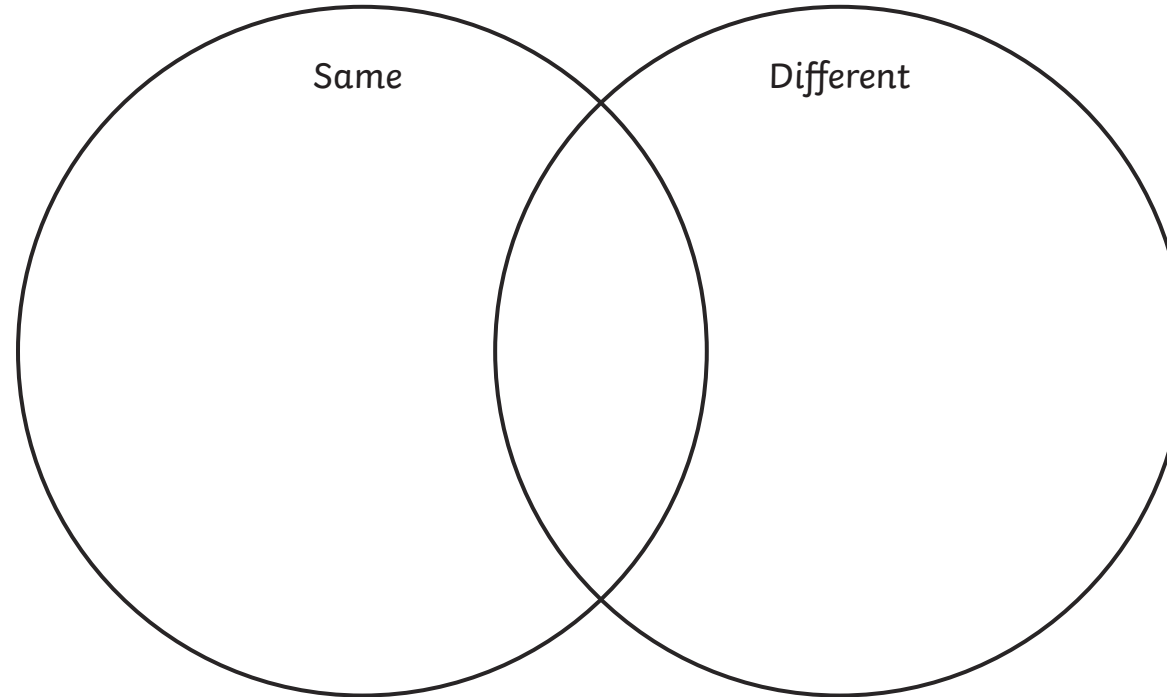
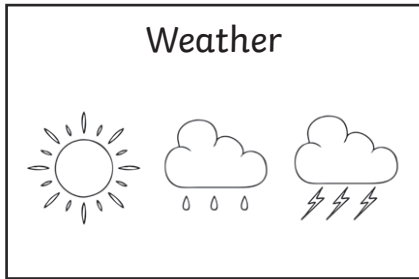
- Why might the building materials be different?
