

Book Voting Station

As developing a love of reading is incredibly important for our little ones, we make books part of our daily routine.

Each Monday, children can vote for the storybook which they would like to read at story time by placing their self-registration card into the corresponding basket. Later we discuss which option has the most votes, by comparing the number of name cards in each basket.

Book choices are shared with parents and carers over the weekend so that children have the opportunity to discuss the books at home and comment on their choices.

Providing an opportunity for our children to vote for a book to be read at story time is a great way to encourage independence and introduce the ideas of fairness, choices and democracy.





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
