Take action to make a difference in our wonderful world. Help to recycle in your home by putting items in the correct bin. Maybe you could reuse materials to create some artwork!



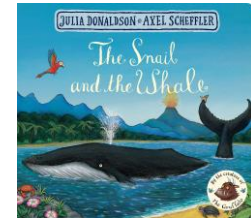
Talk about sun and water safety and/or write a list of items you would put in your suitcase to go on holiday.
