

Uniform Information

We aim to instil pride in wearing Langold Dyscarr uniform and recognise the large number of children who are helped in this way by parents and carers, and look fantastic as a result.

Our school uniform:

- Royal blue school jumper/cardigan: plain or with the school logo on it
- Plain white polo shirt: plain or with the school logo
- Dark grey/black trousers or shorts or skirt or dress
- Black shoes (Velcro shoes are best for our little ones.)
- Girls may wear a blue gingham-style summer dress

School logo jumpers and cardigans can also be ordered online or you may purchase cheaper non logo royal blue cardigan/jumpers from Supermarkets/Matalan etc.

Our PE kit:

In Nursery we have Sure Tots sessions every Monday. It is asked that children come to school in their PE kit on Mondays.

- Plain white t-shirt
- Plain dark shorts or joggers or leggings
- Pumps or trainers

No football kits or branded logo shorts and t-shirts. School logo PE kits can be purchased through the Nationwide School Uniforms website or you may purchase cheaper non logo items from Supermarkets/Matalan etc.

Please ensure ALL items of uniform have your child's name in, even shoes! Things get mixed up very easily when they do not have names in.

Your child will really benefit from being as independent as possible when attending Foundation Stage. Of course, we will always be on hand to help but children feel a real sense of achievement when they can accomplish things by themselves! For

example, your child has access to an outdoor space throughout the day so being able to put their coat on and zip it up independently will really help them.

By way of promoting this independence in FS1 some items of clothing may become mixed up with others. To help with this we ask that you check your child's uniform regularly to ensure they take their own uniform home.
