<u>Fascinating Fact File</u> Can you research a Maya City? What can you find out about it? What was it like? Write a fact file about it. 	<u>Maya Myth</u> Examples of Maya myths are 'The Rain Player' and 'The Chocolate Tree'. Use these to help you write your own. 	<u>Get Creative</u> Design and create your own Maya headdress. Write about the different features of your design and what it would have been worn for. 
<u>Wicked Wrappers</u> Think about your favourite chocolate treat. Design the wrapper for a new chocolate bar you have invented. 	<u>I wonder how...?</u> The Maya loved chocolate. Can you find out how chocolate is made? Draw a flow chart to show the process - remember to use pictures and diagrams to help. 	<u>Colourful Calendar</u> Research the Maya calendar. Create your own out of any materials and explain how it works. 
<u>Where in the World?</u> Where in the world did the Maya live? Use a map to find out. Can you plot the different Maya cities on the map? 	<u>Masterchef</u> The Maya were great farmers and enjoyed eating tortillas filled with cooked vegetables. Design your own Maya tortilla recipe and ask at home if you can make it. Remember to take a photo to bring in and show. 	<u>Fearsome Warrior</u> Using a safe online website or books, use some of the images that you see to draw and label a picture of a Maya warrior. Use materials to make a 3D model of a Maya weapon or item of clothing.
