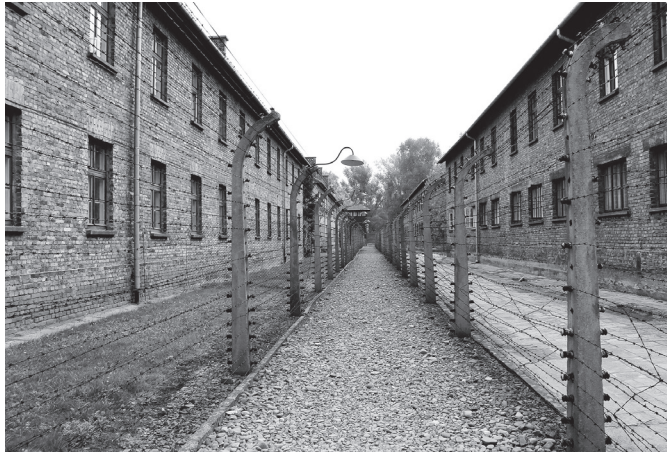


Think

Respond



Use the image to write a poem. Not all poems have to rhyme, but use your senses to describe what you see in the image and other poetry techniques such as alliteration and personification.

Reimagine



Look at the use of perspective in this picture. Draw a picture that shows perspective in the same way. It can be your own interpretation of this image, or one of your own.

Discuss



Concentration camps were first used by the British in the Boer War, with the purpose of containing civilians who might have aided Boer guerrillas. Since then there have been many other uses of such camps, most notably by the Nazis in the Second World War. No matter how they are justified, is there ever a need for such camps?

Solve



One half of this fence is 20m long and 10m wide. Calculate the perimeter?

Challenge: Using these measurements, work out the area?

Discover



Fact: Ann Frank is probably best remembered for her diary, kept during the Second World War. She and her sister, Margot, were sent to the Bergen-Belsen camp in Germany, where they both died of typhus, just before the end of the war.

Question: What else can you find out about Ann Frank? Why are her diaries so famous and so important? Who were her family and what happened to them?

Fences **Answers**

Calculate the perimeter?	Using these measurements, work out the area?
Perimeter = $20\text{m} + 10\text{m} = 30\text{m} \times 2 = 60\text{m}$	Area = $20\text{m} \times 10\text{m} = 200\text{m}^2$
