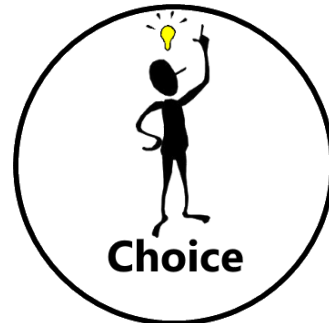

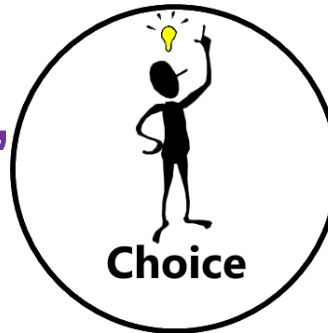
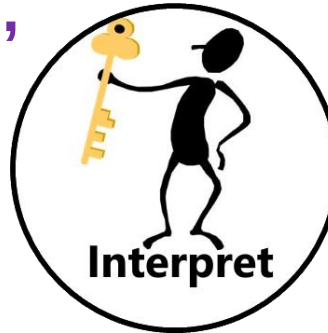
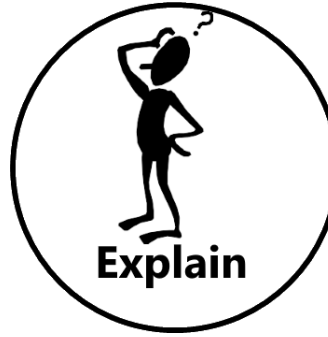
Henry VIII painted by Holbein

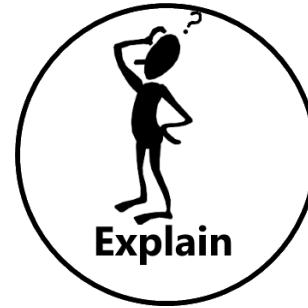

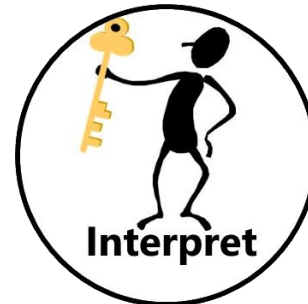

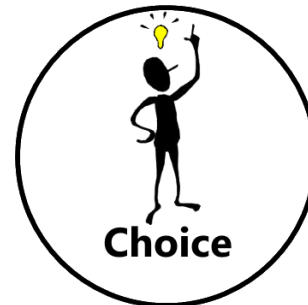
