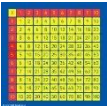


SHANG DYNASTY TAKEAWAY HOMEWORK – SUMMER TERM

<u>English</u>	Use a dictionary to find the definitions of these following topic words; <u>prehistory</u> , <u>dynasty</u> , <u>Shijing</u> , <u>sacrifice</u> , <u>oracle bones</u> .	Free Choice 	Write a poem about a Chinese dragon. Ensure your poem is descriptive, well- presented and decorative.
	What year were you born in? What Chinese lunar calendar animal is it? What are its characteristics? Do you agree with these? Also do this for members of your family. Present it in a fact sheet.	Write a news report about one of the Shang Kings. Include as many facts as you can and pretend that you are a reporter interviewing the King.	Create a fact file, leaflet or PowerPoint about the Shang Dynasty. Include information on hierarchy, living conditions, food, drink, festivals and religious beliefs.
<u>Maths</u>	Make your own Times Table grid. 	What is the weather like in China? Make a bar chart or table of the differences in temperature for each month (Jan to Dec). Then write up some interesting facts and findings you can see from your chart.	Design some VE Day memorabilia, such as medals or bunting, and price them differently under £20. Write which notes and/or coins you could use to buy them. Work out how much change you get if you had £20 and bought 1 or 3 etc.
<u>History/ Science</u>	In your homework book, draw a picture of the country of China showing which continent it is in and the location compared to the UK.	Draw a flower or plant in your homework book and label all the parts; including information about what their purpose is.	Can you create a timeline of the Shang Dynasty? Put in as many dates and events as you can find out from our research.
<u>Creative/ PSHEE</u>	Free Choice 	Draw/paint/make a model of a Chinese dragon.	<u>Financial Education: Let's plan a party!</u> Plan a birthday party with a budget of £25. Find out prices of items and make a list of all the things you will need for the party. There will be 5 people at the party.
