

Battle of Hastings 1066 (14 October)

William of Normandy (France) fought against King Harold II (king of the Anglo-Saxons in England). William believed he should have been crowned king so decided to fight for the throne. After a full day of battle, Harold was killed (it is believed he was shot with an arrow). Shortly afterwards, William became King of England. *Deposed means to be suddenly and forcefully removed from your position of power.*
