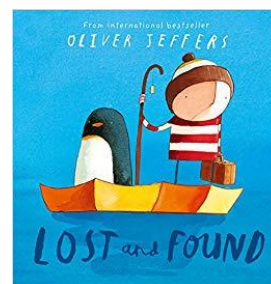


Autumn 2 Newsletter

Our new topic this half term is 'Lost and Found'

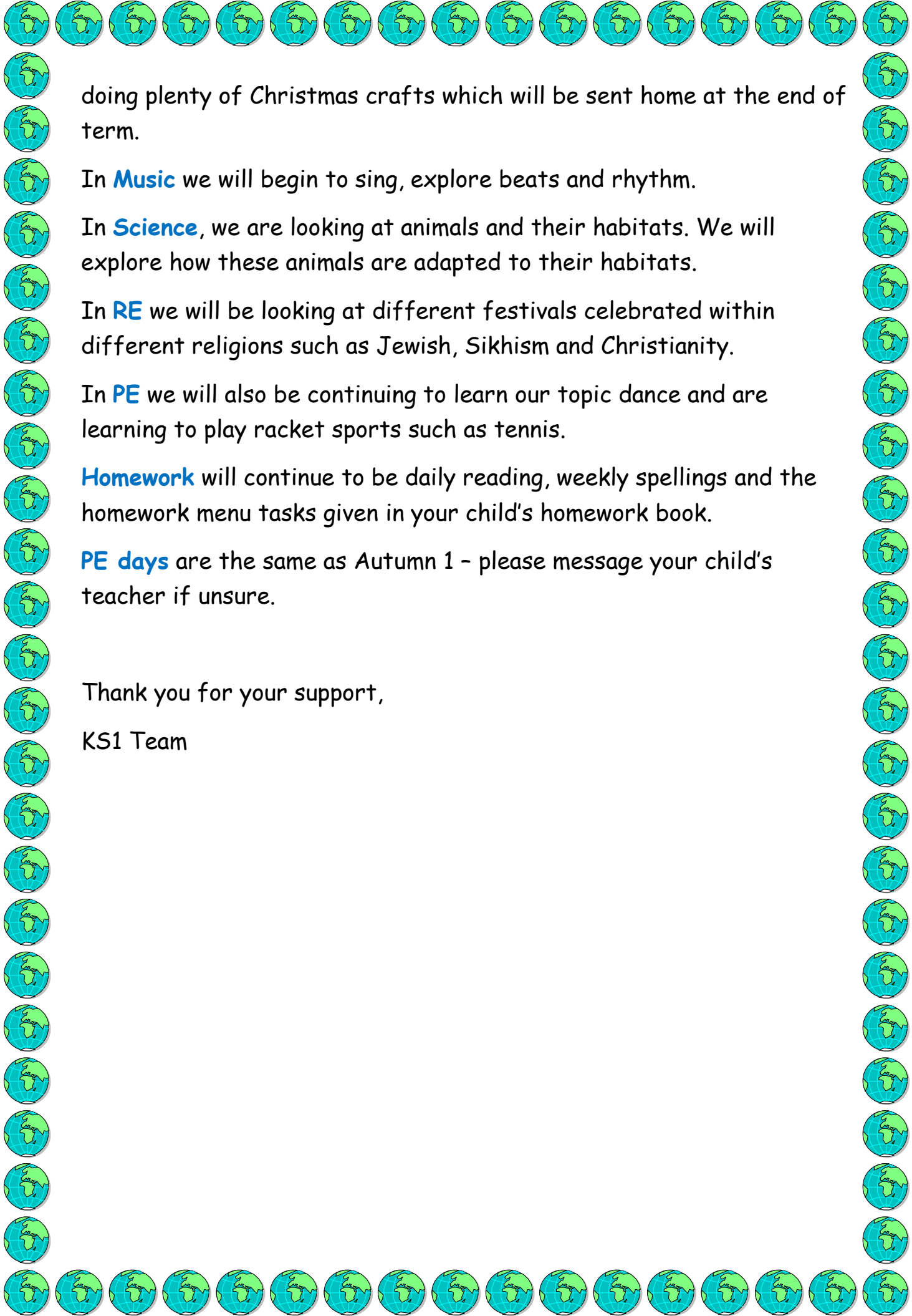
In **English** this half term we will be looking at the book 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers and this will be our inspiration for our writing. We will be writing a mixture of information texts, letters and stories over the term.

In **Maths** this half term, children will continue to learn how to solve a range of problems involving number, shape, space and measure.

In **Computing** lessons, children will learn how to be safe online, including the importance of keeping personal information safe.

Our topic has a **Geography** focus so we will be exploring the 7 Continents and 5 Oceans of the world, looking at atlases and globes to help us. We will be identifying weather patterns and learning about the 4 points on a compass.

In **Art**, we will be creating clay penguins using different tools and making pastel pictures of scenes from our topic book. We will also be



doing plenty of Christmas crafts which will be sent home at the end of term.

In **Music** we will begin to sing, explore beats and rhythm.

In **Science**, we are looking at animals and their habitats. We will explore how these animals are adapted to their habitats.

In **RE** we will be looking at different festivals celebrated within different religions such as Jewish, Sikhism and Christianity.

In **PE** we will also be continuing to learn our topic dance and are learning to play racket sports such as tennis.

Homework will continue to be daily reading, weekly spellings and the homework menu tasks given in your child's homework book.

PE days are the same as Autumn 1 - please message your child's teacher if unsure.
