Lack of after school activities for my child's age range	We are aware of this and do try to balance the clubs. However, we are very proud of the fact that we don't charge for our clubs but this does mean we are reliant on our staff volunteering to run a club after school finishes (often in their own time). We could run more clubs in the future but it would mean a cost to our parents.
I feel that SEMH and SEN needs generally in the school need more support	This school year we have increased our support staff (2 extra) and our ELSA support has also increased
Can school fundraise to support school trips so they aren't cancelled	We subsidise most of our trips and do use our fundraising to do this, many run at a loss to the school.
