(Please note Lunch Club is not included in the extended 30 hours funding.) Lunch Club is not a mandatory charge for parents in relation to their free hours. If parents wish to, they can collect their child at 11.30am and drop them back off at school at 12.15pm.

- You may pay for lunch club and collect your child at 12.15pm.

Application Information

At Langold Dyscarr, children are entitled to 15 hours funded sessions per week or up to 30 hours if eligible. This starts the first full school term after the child's 3rd birthday. Langold Dyscarr provides childcare during school term times only. Funded hours can only be used at Langold Dyscarr towards the morning and afternoon nursery sessions and cannot be used for Lunch Club.

You will be required to complete an online eligibility checker and provide a reference number to confirm your eligibility for 30 hours funded childcare. If you do not qualify for 30 hours, you will still be eligible for 15 hours of standard nursery sessions.

Nursery children are NOT able to attend Breakfast Club or The Hive (afterschool childcare). These clubs become available to children once in Reception (FS2).

What is available at Langold Dyscarr Community School?

MORNING NURSERY SESSION 8.30am – 11.30am	This is a standard nursery session that everyone is entitled to as a 15 hours funded session.
LUNCH CLUB 11.30am – 12.15pm	Only available to 30 hours funded pupils or those accessing paid afternoon spaces. Lunch Club is not included in the standard 15 hours or extended 30 hours funding. Which means a charge of £4.00 per session is required for childcare over the lunchtime period. Lunch Club is not a mandatory charge for parents in relation to their free 30 hours. If parents wish to, they can collect their child at 11.30am and drop them back off at school at 12.15pm. Your child may be collected at 12.15pm after the Lunch Club. This is a standard nursery session that everyone is entitled to as a 15 hours funded session.
AFTERNOON NURSERY SESSION 12.15pm – 3.15pm	Additional afternoon sessions. If your child is entitled to 30 hours you may choose a maximum of 5 afternoon nursery sessions within the week. Parents are encouraged to access their full entitlement, attending all five afternoon sessions where possible. Paid afternoon places are available at a charge of £16.00 per session. Paid afternoon places availability depends on numbers. Ability to offer paid places will be reviewed regularly. Please note the childcare for the 45-minute Lunch Club is not included in the £16.00 charge. Which means a charge of £4.00 per session is required for childcare over the lunchtime period. The total cost for one paid afternoon space (including Lunch Club) is £20.00.

Information on entry to Nursery

Complete and return your application form

You should complete and submit your application form to the school office **as soon as possible**. If you would like to book an appointment to look around the school and nursery, please contact the school office.

Phone Call

The term prior to your child starting we will contact you to arrange a home visit, discuss 30 hours provision and invite you to attend 4 Play Shop sessions. We will tell you all about Langold Dyscarr.

Offer of sessions for 30 hours children only

During the home visit should you require 30 hours provision, you will be given a letter advising you of the School's offer of sessions. You will be asked to indicate your afternoon sessions of choice but where possible parents are encouraged to access their full entitlement.

Home Visit

Your child's teacher will arrange an appointment to visit you and your child at home in preparation for them starting with us. This is an informal chat and an opportunity for your child to get to know their nursery teacher better, as well as a chance for you to ask any questions you may have before your child starts with us. During this home visit you will be given your admissions pack, date of starting, Play Shop dates and code for your transition Class Dojo page.

Play Shops

You and your child will then be able to attend 4 Play Shops at Langold Dyscarr, the half-term prior to starting nursery. This is a chance for your child to stay and meet the nursery staff and other children in the nursery. This is aimed at helping your child to settle into nursery easily when they start with us after half-term. They will include sessions around communication and language, forest schools, messy play/motor skills and a celebration event.

Start Date

Your child will then start with us on the start date provided. Please note all the forms within our admission pack **must be returned** to the school office before your child can take up their place. We must also see a copy of your child's birth certificate to confirm your child's date of birth.
