Choose activities from the menu below to complete at home.
You can complete as many as you like! Have fun and be creative!

1. RESEARCH PROJECT



Choose an aspect of Victorian life to research. This could be transport, schools, children's lives, jobs, medicine or entertainment.

Present your findings in a creative way of your choice.

2. VICTORIAN DIARY



Imagine you are a child (or an adult) living in Victorian times. Write 3 diary entries about your day-to-day life.

Think about your feelings, challenges and hopes.

3. CREATE A POSTER



Design a poster using Victorian-style language to encourage or discourage something (e.g. cleanliness, education, or child labour).

Make it eye-catching!

4. INVENTION SPOTLIGHT



The Victorians were full of incredible inventors! Choose an invention and create a fact file all about it and the person who invented it.

5. ARTWORK



Create a piece of artwork inspired by Victorian life. This could be a sketch, collage, painting or mixed media.

Think about the people, buildings and atmosphere.

6. COMPARE THEN AND NOW



Choose an area of life (e.g. transport, schools, healthcare, housing) and compare Victorian times with today.

Present your comparison in a table, poster or leaflet.

7. VICTORIAN FASHION



Design a Victorian outfit for a man, woman or child. Label the clothing and explain what the outfit would be worn for.

8. NEWSPAPER REPORT



Write a newspaper report about a significant Victorian event (e.g. the opening of the Great Exhibition, or the workhouse system).

Don't forget a headline!

9. BUILD A MODEL



Build a model of a Victorian building or structure. Ideas include a workhouse, railway station, terraced house or factory.

Be as detailed as you can!

10. INTERVIEW A VICTORIAN!



Write a set of interview questions you would ask a Victorian child (or adult) about their life.

Then, write the answers in role as if they were speaking to you!

11. COOK LIKE A VICTORIAN



Find a simple Victorian recipe (e.g. gingerbread, scones, or rice pudding) and have a go at making it!

Write a review and rate it out of 10!
(Don't forget a photo!)

12. FACT QUIZ



Create a quiz all about the Victorians with at least 10 questions.

Include an answer sheet.
